

Comparison of CLASSICAL CONDITIONING & OPERANT CONDITIONING

| | CLASSICAL CONDITIONING | OPERANT CONDITIONING |
|------------------------|--|---|
| Behavior | Involuntary, reflex behavior | Voluntary behavior |
| Response | Response is ELICITED | Response is EMITTED |
| What is learned | An association between ONE STIMULUS (the UCS) and ANOTHER STIMULUS (the CS) | An association between an ANTECEDENT STIMULUS, a BEHAVIOR and a CONSEQUENCE |
| Paradigm | <p>UCS----->UCR</p> <p>CS + UCS----->UCR</p> <p>CS----->CR</p> | <p>S-----> B ----->C</p> <p>Remember as “Psychology’s A, B, Cs</p> |
